On the subsidiarity principle

European Affairs Committee of the Parliament of the Republic of Latvia (Saeima) has carried out a subsidiarity check concerning COM (2016)128 Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Directive 96/71/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 1996 concerning the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of services.

The Saeima European Affairs Committee examined this proposal on May 5, 2016 and decided to adopt a reasoned opinion. The Saeima European Affairs Committee considers that the proposal does not comply with the principle of subsidiarity. Furthermore, it wishes to draw European Commission's attention to certain problematic aspects of the proposed Directive.
