

**Decision of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on the adoption of the  
Opinion on the  
Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the  
European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions  
on the EU Strategy on Combatting Trafficking in Human Beings 2021-2025  
COM(2021) 171**

The Chamber of Deputies:

- supports the objectives and measures of the Strategy;
- recommends organising educational and preventive measures addressed to children, in educational units;
- supports the harmonisation of legislation regarding access to justice for children, victims of the human beings traffic, especially those in the situation in which crimes were committed in the digital environment; supports criminalising the knowing use of services exploited from trafficked persons;
- supports appropriate European funding for research activities, organisations of civil society, community-led and peer-mentoring programmes;
- considers it essential to regularly consult those directly involved in preventing and combating trafficking in human beings; recommends harmonising the European framework for the identification of risk situations and victims of trafficking in human beings;
- supports measures to combat labour exploitation, including through the involvement of trade unions.
