The Chamber of Deputies salutes the advance in the strengthening process of the social dimension of the EU, endorsed by the European Pillar of Social Rights and the initiative especially dedicated to supporting work-life balance for working parents and carers and recommends, in this context, establishing a harmonized support framework, possibly of a recommendatory nature, for parents having under care more than one child and are dealing with a difficult socio-economic situation.

Underlines problems of education as an essential point in work-life balance, and also underlines extracurricular educational activities and draws attention over the objective of developing infrastructure dedicated to child-raising.

The Chamber of Deputies draws attention on paternal leave option's importance, determined not only by economic factors, but also by socio-cultural factors.

Also, it signals supplementary difficulties which microbusinesses and persons practicing liberal professions might have in implementing the provisions of the directive and recommends the regulation of a wider space for negotiation for this kind of situations.
