## **SUMMARY**

## of the Opinion "A Global Partnership for Poverty Eradication and Sustainable Development after 2015" – COM(2015) 44

The Chamber of Deputies notes that the main target of this Communication is to set up the general principles and the key components of a new global partnership for poverty eradication and sustainable development, so that to respond in a transformative manner to the challenges of the post-2015 agenda.

The Chamber of Deputies joins the point of view of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs regarding the position of Romania, namely:

- The Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) set up ambitious targets for the future, observing the three dimensions of the sustainable development: social, economic and environmental. In addition, equally important are the internal and international peace and security, the observance of human rights, the good governance, democracy and the rule of law;
- The Chamber of Deputies supports the universal character of the agenda. The post-2015 development agenda will concern all the states of the world, irrespective of their development level, what will involve an engagement of all the states in order to support it;
- The involvement of the environment ministers is very important to promote the post-2015 development agenda, where the environment should be fully integrated. In this respect, the Chamber of Deputies considers that the environment elements included in the proposal on the Sustainable Development Goals should be preserved and strengthened, one of the main elements being the Sustainable Consumption and Production (SCP).

## The Chamber of Deputies also underlines:

- the importance of the implementation means, in the context of the post-2015 development agenda, which refers both to financial aspects and to the creation of a proper environment for the development of economy, trade, the transfer of technology, the development of capacities;
- the importance of the results of the negotiations which are currently taking place, in order to conclude a new global agreement in the field of climate changes, which is going to be adopted in Paris, in December 2015, for the success of the future agenda;
- the necessity to use the already existing instruments as the Ten Year Framework of Programmes on Sustainable Consumption and Production which represents the most important consolidation process of capacities in the international cooperation in this field.
