**RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE**

Delivered on the 17<sup>h</sup> Session held on the 27<sup>th</sup> of October 2021

**Package on the Transition to a Sustainable Economy and on the Green Bonds**

**The Senate**

**I.**

- 1. Emphasizes**  
the need to choose appropriate tools and timing for implementation of the initiatives;
- 2. Points out**  
the need to take into account the specific conditions and individual needs of different Member States;
- 3. Recalls**  
in this context the importance of natural gas and nuclear energy in case of the Czech Republic;
- 4. Supports**  
setting up appropriate control framework which is transparent and prevents greenwashing;
- 5. Appeals**  
to direct efforts to minimize an increase in administrative burden;
- 6. Accepts**

the introduction of the EUGBS, however, emphasises that the system must remain voluntary;

### **7. Points out**

that although the EUGBS programme is voluntary, for those interested it is complicated and bureaucratic, and therefore it will be important to monitor whether and how will the green bonds be supported or favoured by the Commission in the future;

### **8. Supports**

the Framework Position of the Government of the Czech Republic on these documents, and its long-term position in this agenda in general, and explicitly supports the Government of the Czech Republic in promoting the use of natural gas and nuclear energy in the transition to low-carbon economy;

## **II.**

### **1. Requests**

the Government to inform the Senate by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021 about the way this Resolution was taken into account, and about the further development of negotiations;

### **2. Authorises**

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
