Dear Member of the Senate,

I am writing to you regarding the upcoming legislation and the personal fears it raises for me. Four years ago, I was forced to leave my home country, Türkiye, and seek political asylum. I came to the Netherlands because I believed in Dutch law and trusted that I would be protected and treated equally. When my country neglected my human rights, I found the Netherlands to be a safe haven.

During these four years, I have experienced both good and difficult days, but above all I felt safe and respected. I married another refugee like myself, and within one year of arriving, I began working. My wish has always been to integrate into Dutch society in the best way possible and, in return, to contribute to the society that supported me in my time of need.

However, the upcoming legislation deeply concerns me. For the first time since arriving here, I am beginning to feel the same fear I once felt in my own country. I fear that this law will make life more difficult for thousands of people and hinder their integration into society.

I kindly ask you to reflect on the future this legislation will shape: a future built on fear and division, or one grounded in respect and understanding. It is my sincerest request that you consider the lives it will affect and the legacy it will leave behind.
